**Promoters' Conditions**

1. The competition will be held under A.S.A Laws and A.S.A Technical Rules.
2. The Pool is 50m long x 10 lanes with electronic timing and scoreboard; anti-wave ropes will be used. No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.
3. Team Managers and coaches are responsible for their swimmers throughout the Meet and must supervise the warm up of their swimmers. They are responsible for their swimmers' good behaviour and whereabouts at all times.
4. The age groups are as of 15<sup>th</sup> April 2017 – 9 years, 10 years, 11 years, 12 years, 13 years, 14 years, 15 years and over. Swimmers are eligible to enter their own age group only.
5. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. We may have to close entries prior to the official closing date. Entries may be accepted after the closing date at the promoters' discretion.
6. The heats will be seeded according to submitted entry times, please provide entry times for all swimmers. In fairness to all swimmers entry times will not be updated. It is the competing clubs' responsibility to ensure that all swimmers are entered in the correct age group. .
7. **A copy of accepted entries will be emailed to each participating club. Withdrawals must be notified to the Omega suite at least 75 minutes before the session start time, or prior to the gala by email (pentaqua.clubroom@gmail.com)**
8. Swimmers must report to the competitors' stewards two events prior to their own.
9. Awards will be made to the top three swimmers in each age group in each event after taking into account the cut off times. Speeding Tickets will be awarded to those swimmers who swim faster than the cut off times. Disqualified swimmers are not eligible for any award.
10. Awards will be available from the trophy desk during the sessions after event results have been announced / posted. Top boy and girl awards will be presented to the overall boy and girl accumulating the most points on the day.
11. Full results will be placed on Stocksbridge Pentaqua SC's website ([www.stocksbridgepentaqua.co.uk](http://www.stocksbridgepentaqua.co.uk)) as soon as possible after the meet.
12. The referee's decision will be final on all matters relating to swimming and swimmer discipline.
13. Lockers are provided in the changing rooms. You are advised not to leave any clothing or other items unattended as neither the organisers nor the pool management will accept any responsibility for loss or damage.
14. **In line with the recommendation in the ASA Child Protection Policy, any person wishing to engage in video, zoom or close range photography (including mobile phones with a photographic facility) should register their details, before the event, with staff at the spectator entry desk before carrying out any such photography. An authorisation pass will be issued and must be worn at all times. Any person not complying will be asked to leave the pool complex.**
15. Any matters not covered by these conditions shall be at the promoters' discretion if not covered by ASA Laws or Technical Rules.
