<u>City of Leeds S.C.</u> <u>Club Championships 2025</u> <u>Meet Conditions</u>

- 1. The Competition shall be held under World Aquatics Rules (WAQUA), World Para-Swimming (WPS) rules and regulations where relevant, the British Swimming Judicial Code and any additional conditions (printed in the respective Meet Information). Where WAQUA Rules do not provide (e.g. Health and Safety Regulations or Child Protection Guidelines) the requirements of Swim England shall apply to events held in England.
- 2. All competitors must be registered with Swim England under City of Leeds Swimming Club to enter.
- 3. This competition is open to all City of Leeds registered swimmers aged 8+.
- 4. Age as at 31st December 2025.
- 5. This meet will be run using the linked Sportsystems software, please use a training time where no time is available. Converted long course times can be used and the Sportsystem entry file will be produced to accept these times.
- 6. The promoter reserves the right to limit entries to meet gala license timing restrictions. Where this rule is invoked, the meet will be filled on based on <u>FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS</u>. Rejections will be made in each event to ensure the smooth running of the competition. Events chosen for restrictions will be at the meet organisers' discretion.
- 7. Any entries received after the closing date will be at the discretion of the Entries Secretary.
- 8. Withdrawals

- 9. No poolside entries will be accepted unless the meet is not full, this is at the discretion of the Meet Director
- 10. All events will have two categories Female and Open. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 11. All competitors must go through marshalling. If a competitor does not report to marshalling in time the event will proceed without the competitor.
- 12. Strictly no diving in or climbing over pads is permitted during warm up in the competition pool.
- 13. If cancellation of the event is necessary, then the only claim will be the entry fees paid.



- 14. Refunds will not be given for withdrawn swimmers, for entry errors or omissions attributable to the individual. Only to individuals who can prove they are not fit to compete through evidence of a doctor's note may be given a refund.
- 15. A draft programme will be posted on the web site. All rejected swim refunds will be returned to the relevant swimmer following the gala via the City of Leeds online entry system.
- 16. The Referee's decision regarding the interpretation and judgement of any WAQUA rules or laws is final.
- 17. City of Leeds Swimming Club accepts no responsibility for loss or damage to competitors personal belongings, how so ever caused, unless such damage is caused by the negligence of the City of Leeds Swimming Club.
- 18. City of Leeds Swimming Club and the Meet Organisers are not responsible for individual swimmers on poolside. All swimmers on poolside should be accompanied by a person with a coaches pass and who has had a DBS check.
- 19. If the event the competition is cancelled all entries will be refunded in full.
- 20. "Over the top" starts will be used in the heats at the discretion of the promoter.
- 21. Backstroke ledges will be available and used at the promoter's discretion.
- 22. Spectators are not permitted to enter poolside.
- 23. No swimmers are allowed up to the balcony.
- 24. Swimmers must wear footwear when leaving the pool area.
- 25. A mobile strobe will be available throughout the competition. Any competitor who needs to use it should notify the event referee prior to the start of the session.
- 26. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
- 27. Swimmers with a disability shall swim under IPC Rules.
- 28. Qualifying times for disability competitors are not required. However, entry times shall be submitted for the purpose of seeding the heats.
- 29. Personal Care Attendants/Coaches: Personal care attendants will only be permitted for swimmers in the following classes: S1, S2, S3, S4, S5 and S11. A swimmer in any of these classes may have both a coach and a personal care attendant present. No charge will be applied for personal care attendant. Poolside passes: coaches' passes shall attract the advertised fee. All coaches, chaperones and personal care attendants must conform to the Swim England child protection procedures and hold a current DBS certificate.
- 30. The competition format will be based on disability inclusion within the able-bodied programme i.e. there will be no separate events for swimmers with disabilities. All swimmers will be seeded in the heats according to their entry times. Disability competitors will be included within the results for their age group.
- 31. Officials are reminded that City of Leeds Swimming Club is an environmentally responsible club and aims to limit the use of single use plastic. Therefore, please do bring a water bottle, we will happily keep it filled up.

- 32. All officials are required to use the upstairs changing facility, whilst swimmers must use the poolside changing rooms.
- 33. No camping chairs are allowed to be used in the facility.
- 34. For swimmers be considered and selected for the mixed relay cannon event they must enter the 50m Freestyle within this competition.
- 35. Any point not covered by these rules will be at the discretion of the Meet organiser.
